 - PSSA testing for 3-8 graders began on April 22, 2024.
 - May 1st May 2nd (Science PSSA Assessment 4th grade only)
 - May 6th May 10th (PSSA make-Ups)
 - The PSSA is an important tool that provides critical information about the academic progress of your student(s). Individual student scores help teachers identify a child's strengths and areas for growth, which in turn allows teachers to personalize a child's instruction to best support their growth. PSSA scores also provide information to schools and the District to support improvement and planning around curriculum and instruction.
 - The PSSA is state mandated, and participation by all students in grades 3-8 is required by federal law. Therefore, it is very important for students to attend school daily and remain enrolled in school during the testing window.
