- The first day of school for students in grades Kindergarten through 5th is
 Monday, August 26, 2024.
- o In order to ensure the safety of all of our students on the first day of school, please adhere to the following:
- Students in grades 1-5 should arrive no earlier than 9:00 AM- All returning students will arrive for the first day of school and return to their teacher/classroom that they were in for the 2023-2024 School Year. Teachers will have the opportunity to welcome students back and will transition them to their new teacher. All students that are new to Lawton will report to the cafeteria upon entry.
- Students in grades 1-2 will enter through the "D" door in the small yard.
 Students in grades 3-5 will enter through the "C" door in the large yard. Parents will not be permitted to enter the school building.
- O 2024-2025 Kindergarten students should arrive at 10:00 AM- Teachers will meet their classes in the large yard. Students will enter with their teacher through the gym door and proceed to their classroom. Parents will not be permitted to enter the school building to walk students to the classroom.

- o Grades 1 & 2 will be dismissed in the small yard.

- Lawton has been using the School District messaging system to send reminders and updates. If you have not received emails or phone calls from us, please make sure that we have the correct phone number(s) on file for you.
- Please sign up to the Parent Portal if you did not do so already. This is the messaging system that sends both phone and email reminders/notifications.
- Students are to wear the school uniform every day. School uniform is tan/khaki bottoms and navy blue or white polo shirt. Hoodies are not permitted at any time.
- The gym uniform should be worn on gym days. It consists of gray sweatpants/shorts and a plain red T-shirt. Hoodies are not permitted at any time.
- Early dismissals are for emergencies/urgent circumstances only. Students miss instructional time as teachers provide instruction until the end of the school day.
- Anyone picking up a child from school early must have a picture ID to show to staff before a child can be released. Parents/guardians must provide the names of those who are permitted to pick up their child on the forms provided. We cannot and will not release a child without written notification from a parent and photo ID of the person
